



Well the jinks still prevails. Even the name change didn't help. Last year North couldn't participate in what was called, at the time, 'The CRN Elite Duals' due to a skin situation. This year one team dropped out of the six team event early on and another had skin issues of their own. That left a field of four with Western Wayne questionable because of weather concerns. Western Wayne did make it to fill out the roster which made for a much better event.

Council Rock North matched up with the Wildcats of Western Wayne on mat one while Council Rock South took on Upper Moreland on mat two. Western Wayne is a district two school from Lake Areil, PA. Lake Areil is located in Wayne County just east of Scranton. They came into the tournament undefeated and had placed fourth in the Tunkhannock Kiwanis Holiday Tournament. Wrestling started with the 135 pound weight class with a decision win for **Tyler Kelly**. A win by a fall at 135 for WW was followed by **Anthony Dutrow's** pin in the 145 weight class. **Hayden Schenker** picked up the win by major decision at 152. In the upper weights, North gave up five in a row to Western Wayne. That made the team score 13 - 35. **Mike Jeronis** picked up a win by way of a forfeit at 103. The 112 pound bout went to the Wildcats. Another win by forfeit for **Adam Slezak** at 119 and the Indians closed out the match with two quick pins by **Shane Longstreth** and **Johnny Dutrow** in the 125 and 130 pound bouts respectively. Not quite enough as Western Wayne took their first match 37-38.

Next up the Golden Bears of Upper Moreland. This would be the second time North has faced Upper Moreland this season. Back in early December the Indians lost to the Bears at the Boyertown Bear Duals. That one went to Upper Moreland by a score of 39-41. This time the Indians hoped to avenge that loss. North took ten of the fourteen individual bouts. Notable were the efforts of **Aldan Ely** who

held the Bears Will Dill to a 2-7 decision and **Tyler Callenders** first varsity win at heavy weight. Final score North 55 UM 16.

Council Rock North wrestled Council Rock South in the third match of the day. The bouts were split, six for North and eight for South. All but one of the fourteen individual bouts were won by way of bonus points. South had seven pins and a tech fall while North carded two pins, two tech falls, a major decision and a minor decision. The final score South 47 North 29. **Shane Longstreth** scored his fall in 0:54. In the earlier matches **Shane** had two more quick pins. One in 0:36 and the other in 0:25. For that effort **Shane** was awarded the plaque for most pins in the least amount of time.
