## CRNorth JV vs Neshaminy JV

On December twenty second Council Rock North hosted the first Best of Bucks Junior Varsity dual meet in North's main gym. There were a couple of holes but for the most part each school was able to field nearly a complete squad. North started the action on mat one against Neshaminy while Council Rock South squared off against Bensalem on mat two.

Freshmen **Tim Ambacher** started things off in the 112 pound weight class against Blaise Capriotti of Neshaminy. **Tim** controlled the first period pushing the bout into the second period where he turned the Neshaminy grappler and pinned him in 3:17. **Tim** is looking good for a spot in next year's lineup in the light weight.

The wrestling jumped to the 160 bout where junior **Kevin Murray** out scored Neshaminy's Evan Pascucci 6-2 to take the bout by way of decision. A little more improvement and **Kevin** should see a lot of action next year.

Back to North's 119 pounder sophomore **Evan Dienstman**. The Indian 19 pounder had little trouble with his Neshaminy opponent taking the bout by way of a fall adding six to CRN's score. Another good looking prospect for the 2011 - 2012 season.

**Andrew Parker** took on the Redskin's Brandon Chateneski in the 125 pound bout. **Andrew** controlled the bout allowing Chateneski just one point on his way to the 4-1 decision win. By the effort **Andrew** displayed tonight we will surely be a factor next year.

North's **Goldstein** and Neshaminy's Chris McMullen hooked up in the evening's longest bout in the 130 weight class. **Jesse Goldstein**, one of the three Goldstein brothers wrestling tonight, tied things up in the third period to send the bout into overtime. It took **Jesse** three OT periods to finally card the win by way of a 7-7 win by sudden victory (SV). If **Jesse** keeps getting better there may be a couple of Goldsteins in next year's lineup.

Junior **Kevin Janiczek** used a cradle in the second period to take the 135 pound bout. **Kevin** locked up the cradle and turned the Redskin's Sean Hasting in the second period to record the fall in 3:37. It's a pretty good guess that **Kevin** should be an important fact as a senior member of next year team.

**Patel** is a familiar name in North wrestling. Brother Neil who wrestled in the 145 pound weight class last year was in the stands to watch brother **Raj's** wrestling debut in the 140 pound bout. Neil had to be impressed as brother **Raj** put away his Neshaminy opponent with a 1:24 fall. **Raj** is another guy that will be bringing something to the Indian squad in 2011-12.

At 145, **Chris Child** had no problem with the Redskin's Jay Birbeck. **Chris** totally controlled the bout start to finish compiling an impress 13-3 major decision over his Neshaminy foe. As a senior next year **Chris** is sure to bring some strength to North's middle weight.

The third **Goldstein** to wrestle tonight didn't fare to well. **Cody Goldstein** took on Neshaminy's Kody Luper in the 152 pound bout. **Cody** got caught and was pinned in the first period. That is not indicative of how **Cody** can wrestle. Given the opportunity we will see much better things from this scrappy senior.

Wrestling jumped to 215 where freshmen **Colin Kaschak**, the third of three Kaschak brothers to wrestle for North, took on Neshaminy's Christian Chateneski. **Colin** shutout the Redskin grappler by a score of 7-0 to card a three point decision win for the Indian's. In the next three years **Colin** should be an anchor in the heavy weights for the Indians.

The Match ended in the 285 pound bout with North's freshmen **James Dutrow** taking on Neshaminy's Connor Hafner. **James** took Hafner down and put on a half and the ref called the pin in 1:29 of the first period. The way **James** has been wrestling bodes well for North's upper weights next season.

When all was said and done, Council Rock North Junior Varsity had outscored the team from Langhorne 43-6 a nice indication of things to come. Nice going guys!!

The second match pitted the Indians of Council Rock North against the Owl of Bensalem with wrestling starting in the 215 pound weight class. **Colin Kaschak** took on the Owls Alex Tran and recorded his second win of the evening with an impressive 3:05 fall over his Bensalem opponent.

**Tim Ambacher** was up next against the Owls 112 pounder Tyler Anderson. This one proved to be a test for **Tim** but he prevailed with a 5 – 1 decision win his second for the night.

In the 119 bout **Max Goldstein** took on the owl's Tyler Shuchart. **Max** wrestled tough but had a tough time with his Bensalem opponent and was pinned two thirds of the way through the second period.

**Brian Hong** followed in the 125 match against the Owl's Cameron Lentchart. This was a hard fought bout but in the end the win went to the Bensalem grappler via a fall in the third period.

The 135 pound bout saw **Kevin Janiczek** match up with the Owl's David Nightlinger. It became obvious that the Bensalem wrestler had underestimated his Indian opponent. Just when it looked like the match was going his way **Kevin** caught him with a Pederson and quickly transitioned it into a headlock and to his surprise Nightlinger was pinned in the second period. Two pins, two wins for the lanky 35 pounder.

**Chris Child**, the Indian's 45 pounder, won his second bout of the evening over the Owl's Pauray Patel. **Chris** outscored Patel with an 11 – 0 shutout for the win by major decision. On the night **Chris** had scored twenty-four points to his opponent's three. Pretty impressive work for the Indian junior.

North's 152 pounder, **Cody Goldstein** just couldn't catch a break. **Cody** wrestled tough in his second bout of the evening and lost a 0 – 2 squeaker to the Owl's Robert Lee.

**Matt O'Neill** had looked good in an earlier 171 exhibition bout. In the JV match against Bensalem he looked even better. **Matt** was matched up against the Owl's Eric Champey. He totally dominated the bout for the better part of two periods pinning Champey in 3:55. This fiery sophomore may bring some stability to the upper weights next year.

In the 189 pound bout Bensalem's Dustin Robinson caught **Mitch Jenkins** with a headlock right off the get go. **Mitch** fought the headlock and was able to get a leg in and roll Robinson and hit a headlock of his own. All of this in only 1:47 for the win for North. Another good looking heavier weight for next year.

The 285 pound bout was the last of the evening matching **James Dutrow** against Bensalem's Angel Sosa. This was the second meeting between these two. They had wrestled a week earlier when North met Bensalem in their varsity match. That one went **James'** way when he pinned Sosa in 3:08. This time Sosa got his revenge with a 2:36 fall. The rubber match should be something to see.

The final score of the match was North 34 Bensalem 21. This was a great outing for the young guys and hopefully they will get many more opportunities to wrestle this year.
