



This is the first time in recent memory that Council Rock North won't be making the trip to Hershey. The Boyertown Bears spoiled the Indian's travel plans last night in the second round of the District Duals at Pottsgrove Middle School with a 37 – 33 win. Wrestling started in the 189 pound weight class. North lost that one and the next three, spotting the Bears twenty-one big points. From there it was a slow uphill battle, but the Indians just couldn't overcome that large a deficit. North split the matches seven and seven. The problem being that Boyertown racked up more bonus points in their half of the wins.

With the score at 0 – 21, **Micah Haynes** got North on the scoreboard with a 5 – 0 shutout over the Bear's Matt Duncan in the 112 pound bout.

Johnny Dutrow (119) and **Shane Longstreth** (125) paired up with a couple of quick pins, 0:38 and 0:23 respectively, to see the Indians draw to within six points of the Bears with the score at 15 – 21.

Boyertown took the 130 by way of a Major and the 135 with a pin to take back eleven of those twelve points, and that quick the Bear's lead was doubled at 15 – 31.

In the 140 pound bout **Anthony Dutrow** took on the Bear's David Waight. **Anthony** did everything he could, but just couldn't turn Waight and had to settle for a 6 – 1 decision.

Likewise in **Hayden Schenker's** 145 pound match up with Ross Herrlinger. These Bears were coached well at staying off their backs. Bars, halves and cradles, nothing would work. A frustrating 7 - 4 decision win was the best **Hayden** could do. After those two wins, back to a ten point difference at 21 – 31. Still doable, but the Indians would have to take the last three bouts.

A loss by way of a pin at the 152 pound bout and it was over for the Indians. A bit anticlimactic, but North finished strong with a pair of wins in the 160 and 171 pound bouts. **Drew DiSpirito** looked real good in his 160 pound bout against Chase Garber. He controlled the entire bout and finally decked Garber late in the third period, recording the fall in 5:56.

Brendon Poff moved down from 189 to 171 and took on Boyertown's Adam Kulp. **Brendon** looks real comfortable at that weight. In his first bout in that weight slot, against Pennsbury, he beat the Falcon's Josh Caven 2 - 1. Last night he looked equally as good scoring a 3:59 fall against his Boyertown opponent.

A nice finish, but no cigar. Boyertown will now move on to meet Council Rock South in the next round. The Indians will have to get a good night's sleep and regroup for tomorrow afternoon's match with league rival Harry S Truman at Truman. JV to start at 12noon with the varsity to follow at 1:30pm.
