**CRN vs BE**

The Golden Hawks of Council Rock South had beaten the Owls by a score of 41-23. Now it was the Indians turn to take on Bensalem.

North's **Mike Jeronis** wrestled the Owl's Mike Pritchard tough in his 113 pound bout, but came out on the short end of the 4-2 decision. Giving the first bout to Bensalem. At 120 **Micah Haynes** pinned Bensalem's Tyler Anderson in the second period. There was no clock so the exact time was not available. During the bout the Bensalem coach said something that referee Andy Cedars apparently didn't like and Bensalem was penalized a team point putting the score at North 6 Bensalem 2.

The 126 pound bout went to the Owls, followed by three straight first period pins by the Indians starting off with **Johnny Dutrow** at 132, **Tyler Kelly** at 138 and **Aldan Ely** at 145. The Owls came back with pins in the 160 and 170 pound bouts. That put the team score at Indians 24 Owls 17.

Two more first period pins by **Matt O'Neill** at 170 and **Brendon Poff** at 182 set the team score at 36-17. The Owls took a decision at 195 bumping the score at 36-20 with three bouts to go. Bensalem was still in it mathematically, but **Tyler Callender** iced the win for the Indians with his first period pin of the Owl's 220 pound Alex Tran. That put the match out of reach for the Owls with the score 42-26.

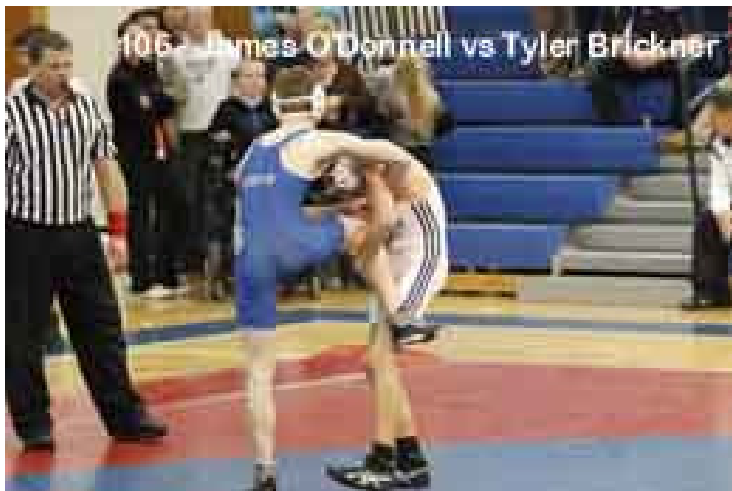
The 285 pound bout was probably one of the more exciting hookups of the evening. That bout pitted North's sophomore **James Dutrow** against Bensalem's senior Angel Sosa. Last year as a freshman, **James** pinned Sosa in their Best of Bucks bout. In Sections that year Sosa pinned **James**. This would be the rubber match between these two. This one was a thriller with both guys trading points for three exciting periods. In the end the bout went to Sosa by a score of 5-3. Can't wait to see these two go at it again in the post season.

The final bout of the evening went to Bensalem's 106 pounder Tyler Brickner by decision over the Indian's **James O'Donnell** by a score of 4-1. In the end the fourteen bouts were split seven and seven between CRN and Bensalem. The difference was that all of North's wins were by way of pins while the majority of Bensalem's wins were by decision. Final score CRN 42 Owls 26.

While North was carding their second win of the night, Council Rock South had lost to Neshaminy. That is going to make for a very interesting match between those two for the Unity Cup later next year.

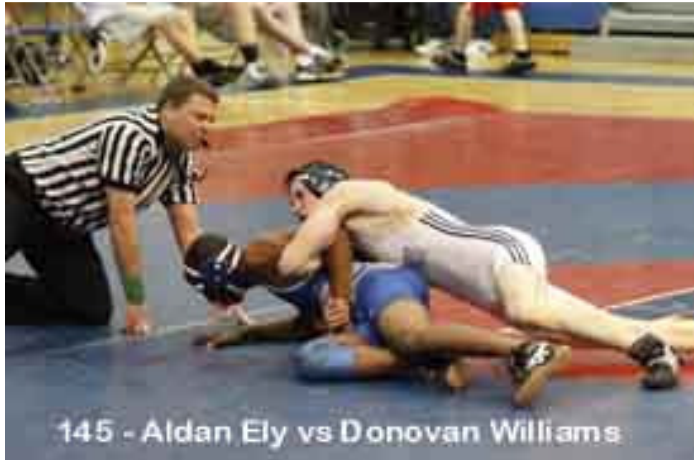

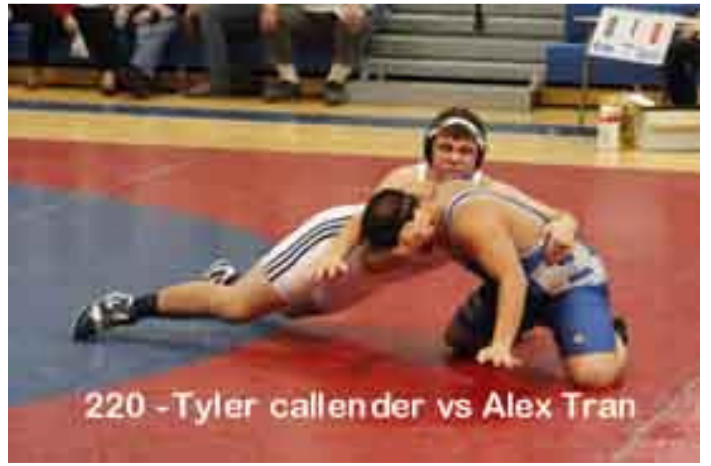
