



Council Rock North had little trouble chalking up another SOL win over Abington. The Ghosts who normally put a really tough, highly competitive team on the mat were lack luster at best tonight. Wrestling started at 135 where North ran off five straight before Abington was able to put something on the scoreboard.

Hayden Schenker kicked thing off with a 7-3 decision win over the Ghost's Brian Lee. The Rock put all pins together to take the next three. In the 140 pound bout, Anthony Dutrow got his win in 2:53. James Hollawell became a member of the under a minute club with a 0:48 pin at forty-five and Greg Lanctot finished the pin string by way of a fall in 1:38 in the 152 pound bout. If you add all of that up you'd find that those three bouts were completed in less than six minutes at 5:19. Jamey (Mad Dog) Kelly who has had a rough year capped the five bout string with a 3-2 win over Abington's Ian Lambert.

The hundred and seventy-one pound bout went to Abington but that one bout string was broken when Jamie Callender pinned James Allmond, Abington's eighty-nine pounder, in 0:38. Jayfie Kaschak followed at 215, with a 9-8 squeaker over the Ghost's Bryan Osei. Abington got their second win in the 285 pound weight class which saw the team score go to North 33 the Ghosts 12.

Neither team put a three pounder on the mat so the 103 pound bout was declared no match. Jonnie Dutrow made short work of Abington's Mike Molz with a pin in 1:15 at 112. At 119 a shutout for Shane Longstreth with a 15-0 tech fall which boosted the team score to 44-12. Abington scored their final points for the evening with a win at 125 and Allan Slezak finished the scoring for North with a 14-6 major decision win in his 130 pound bout with Abington's Mike McCaughey.
