

DISTRICT 1 DUALS

The snow had everything so bollixed up that for a while it started to look like there might not be any District One Duals. But, Mother Nature finally began to cooperate and the Duals managed to be held on Monday February 8th at Pottstown High School. The District Committee had to eliminate one round of consolations to insure that all of the wrestling could be done in one day.

In the quarter finals, Council Rock North will go up against seventh seeded West Chester Henderson who had beaten Downingtown East to make their way into the quarters. WCH is a member of the Ches-Mont League's American Conference with a 4-1 league record and are 10-6 overall. The only common opponent WCH and CRN have had is Bensalem who WCH had beaten 42-21 earlier in the season. North had beaten the Owls 47-18 back in January. Looking at those results, it appears this quarter final match could be a doozy..

Wrestling was delayed a bit but finally got under way around 4:30pm. **Jamie Callender** was up first in the 215 pound bout against West Chester Henderson's Matt Muscari. **Jamie** took total control of the bout scoring a tech fall in five minutes flat.

Jayfie Kaschak moved up to take on the other Muscari brother in the 285 pound bout. The best **Jayfie** could do against the Worrier's heavy weight was an escape in the last period in the 6-1 loss.

WCH's three pounder, Jim Long, scored all of the points handing North's **Sean O'Neill** a 7-0 loss.

Freshman **John Dutrow** had little trouble with the Warrior's junior twelve pounder. It was all **John**, scoring in all three periods to pile up a 15-0 tech fall in just under six minutes which started a run of four in a row for the Indians.

North took the next three bouts starting with **Shane Longstreth's** 5-2 decision over WCH's Josh Demi. The **Slezak** brothers paired up to take the next two. **Adam** shutout Charlie Grab 8-0 and **Allan** outscored the Warrior's Nick Schmidt 7-2. The team score at that point was CRN 20 WHC 6.

Hayden Schenker dropped a tech fall to Henderson pushing the Warrior's score into double digits at 20-11.

Tyler Kelly stepped in at 140 and lost a close 4-2 decision to Henderson's Stash Grab which pulled the Warriors to within six points at 20-14.

The 145 pound bout had to be the most exciting of the evening thus far. This one was a no holds barred, Katie bar the door slug fest between two aggressive styles. It was, you counter me and I'll counter you and somehow **Anthony Dutrow** always managed to come out of it with the points. The final tally, **Anthony** fourteen, Albert Snoh 4.

Following that one were two wins for North. **James Hollawell** took a 7-2 decision from Nick Castello and **Greg Lanctot** majored Derek Matonti 15-1. **Greg's** win clinched the win for the Indians with a team score 32-14.

The Warriors and the Indians split the final two bout. Henderson took the 171 pound bout with a tech fall and **Joe Coates** finished out the match with an 8-4 decision win over the Warrior's Tyler Benson. Final score CRN 35 WCH 19. That win sets up a match with Boyertown in the semi finals. Boyertown advanced to the semis when Upper Moreland was forced to forfeit. The rumor was it was for an unconfirmed skin situation.
