



KISKI AREA CAVALIERS

Both of this year's matches, at the State Duals, came down to the last bout. But, the old Hershey jinks jumped up and bit Council Rock North once again.

Council Rock North started with their preliminary match against Kiski Area High School. They were second place winners from District Seven which encompasses teams from the Pittsburgh area.

After a loss, by decision, at 285 to open the match, North jumped on the Cavs and took the next five in a row. **Sean O'Neill** started the string with a pin in the 103 pound bout over Kiski's Steve Stramaski. **Sean** took Stramaski down and put him on his back for two, early in the first period and then turned him again and the fall was called in 1:46.

A pair of freshmen matched up in the 112 pound bout. The Cavalier's Cole Landowski took to the mat with an impressive 25-6 record, but he couldn't handle North's **Johnny Dutrow**. **Johnny** gave up just an escape and a takedown on his way to a 9-3 win. **Johnny** just keeps getting better and better.

The 119 pound bout pitted two guys with almost identical records. North's **Shane Longstreth** (21-9) against Kiski's Adam Rosensteel (23-9). **Shane** got the early takedown in the first period and Rosensteel managed an escape. In the second, **Shane** was on the bottom and reversed and rode Rosensteel for the remainder of the period. **Shane** on top in the third turned Rosensteel for two to cap the scoring at 6-1. A real nice win for the junior lightweight.

The **Slezak** brothers both won a couple of tough bouts. **Adam** (125) out scored Kiski's Jim Bistline by a score of 6-1, while **Allan** followed in the 130 pound bout with a 7-3 decision win over the Cav's Beau Grzybek. That ran the team score to 18 North 3 Kiski.

Following a loss at 135 **Anthony Dutrow** (140) took on the Cav's Zach Musco. Musco got the takedown in the first period and **Anthony** escaped to be taken down again but escaped at the buzzer. Bad first period for **Happy Bull**, but he took control in the second period. Starting on top he turned Musco three times for a total of eight points. Musco scored two in the third period but too little to late as **Anthony** took the bout by a score of 10-6.

That was to be all for North until **Jamie Callender's** 189 pound bout. When **Jamie** stepped on the mat the team score was Indians 21 Cavaliers 26. When he came off the mat the score was tied at 26 as **Jamie** gave the Cav's Bill Emerick a clinic in takedowns to run the bout score to 26-8 scoring the tech fall in exactly 5:00.

The match went to Kiski as they took the final bout by way of a fall which gave them the six point advantage and a final score of 32-26. A really tough loss for the boys from Newtown. Next up a match with Shikellamy in the first round of consolations.
