



Council Rock North's next opponent will be Shikellamy who dropped to the consolations after a loss in the quarter finals to Canon McMilan by a 31-30 score. Shikellamy High School made it to States as the District Four Champions. District Four is located in North Central Pennsylvania and takes in the Williamsport, Sudbury region. A pretty darn good wrestling area.

Another good start with four in a row for North. This time it was **Johnny Dutrow's** turn to get things going for the Indians as he went up against the Braves 112 pounder, Landry Badman. **Johnny** scored first with a takedown which would have been enough as he blanked the junior wrestler from Shikellamy by a score of 5-0.

In 119 pound bout it was a let'em up take'em down contest as **Shane Longstreth** scored the first takedown in the initial period, a reversal and five takedowns in the second and two in the third for a total of eight takedowns in all to hand the Brave's Robert Easton an 18-9 major decision loss.

Adam Slezak recorded his second win of the day over Joey Zoda (17-7). **Adam** used a takedown, an escape and a pair of reversals to outscore Zoda 7-3.

Allan Slezak and the Brave's Jake Shrawder went scoreless in the first period of the 130 pound bout. **Allan** got an escape and a takedown in the second and allowed Shrawder an escape in the third to take the bout by a score of 3-1. To this point the Indian's had shutout the Braves 13-0.

North lost the 135 pound bout on a rather dubious caution call giving the bout to Shikellamy 2-1. In the 140 pound bout, **Anthony Dutrow** got the initial takedown and rode Jake Hummel for the balance of the period. Fifty-seven seconds into the second period **Anthony** turned Hummel and it was all over as the ref slapped the mat and called the fall.

James Hollawell (145) used a pair of second period near falls to score four points and take a 4-2 decision win over the Braves Michael Barnhart. Things still looking good for North with the team score at 22-3.

CRN lost the next three weight classes by way of a 4-1 decision, a 15-8 major decision and a 2:15 fall. Suddenly the score had drawn to close for comfort at 22-16.

Dominic Wolfe didn't look worthy of his 21-6 record as **Jamie Callender** took him down and put him on his back for three before pinning him in 1:32. Of course **Jamie** has a way of making the best look pretty bad. That six points made the team score look a little better at 28-16 with three bouts to go.
